2006-07: Planning and Preparation for Transition

- SASI continues one more year
- Plan PowerSchool implementation
- Initial Product Training for IS&T Staff and Lead Team: Jan. 16-19
- PowerScheduler Training for designated secondary staff: Jan. 30-31
- Prepare, clean, and migrate data to new system: Oct. - August
- Customize new system as needed: Oct. - August
- Initial Product Training for current SASI users: April 17-19, 24-26 & May 1-3, 8-10
- PowerScheduler (Part 2) Training for designated secondary staff: June 19-21.
- PowerSchool Teacher "Train-the-Trainer" Sessions scheduled for lead teachers: Sign up for May 24th or 31st
- PowerSchool Teacher: Prof. Development available for all teachers who may sign up for: June 19 or 21, August 14 or 16 (additional dates available upon site request). For teachers who have not signed up or are new employees, training will be offered at school on 8/27.

2007-08: Year 1 - PowerSchool Goes Live!

- PowerSchool goes live and SASI goes away on July 3
- K-12 grades: All teachers take attendance online
- 7-12 grades implement PowerGrade
- Second quarter/mid-trimester: 7-12 grades implement parent portal
- **Second semester/trimester: 7-12 grades begin transition from PowerGrade to new web grade book**

2008-09: Year 2

- 7-12 grades continue to transition from PowerGrade to the new web grade book
- 4-6 grades implement web grade book (voluntary for E3 grant teachers)
- 4-6 grades plan/design new progress reports

2009-10: Year 3

- 4-6 grades implement web grade book and new progress reports
- **Second trimester: 4-6 grades implement Community/parent portal**
- K-3 grades plan/design progress reports

2010-11: Year 4

- K-3 grades implement new web grade book and progress reports
- **Second trimester: K-3 grades implement Community/parent portal**
